

2019 CARTERSVILLE FARMER'S MARKET GUIDELINES & RULES

- Season:** June 1, 2019 through September 28, 2019
Time: Every Saturday, 7am – 12pm
Location: Founders Oak parking lot, across from City Hall, in downtown Cartersville
Cost: \$35 for season permit, no weekly rent

Items accepted for sale at market:

- Locally grown produce (from Bartow, Pickens, Cherokee, Cobb, Paulding, Polk, or Floyd counties)
- Locally grown fresh cut flowers
- Locally raised honey
- Locally raised eggs and meat (all necessary permits are required)
- Baked goods (ingredients MUST be listed on each item)
- Canned goods and jellies (ingredients MUST be listed on each item)
- Handmade craft items

Items not accepted for sale at market

- Resale items
- Mass produced or commercial items
- CBD oil or supplements
- Any other items deemed inappropriate by the market manager or DDA staff

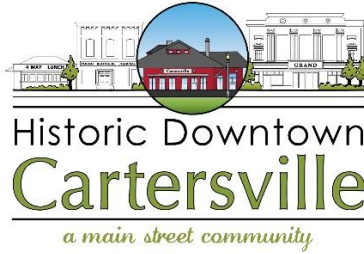
Rules and Requirements

- Farmers Market permit must be clearly displayed while at the market.
- Those with a permit may set up on a first come, first served basis. There are no assigned spots.
- Vendors may start to set up at 5:00am on Saturday for the start of the market at 7:00am.
- Due to traffic and safety concerns, vendors are required to stay for the duration of the market each day.
- Each permit entitles vendors to a single 10x10 tent in the market area. Tents must be securely weighted. Any injury or damage from improperly secured tents will be the responsibility of the vendor.
- All food, decorations, and booth materials must be brought in and removed the same day of the market.
- Vendors shall conduct themselves in a responsible, friendly, manner. Obscenity, yelling, or other discourteous behavior is prohibited and may result in revocation of market permit.
- It is the responsibility of the vendor to obtain all necessary permits and licenses for the sale of their items.
- By participating in the Cartersville Farmer's Market, vendors authorize any random inspection of the property where the items mentioned on application are produced.
- No alcohol is allowed at the market for any reason.
- No refunds will be given for any reason.

The City of Cartersville and Downtown Development Authority accept no responsibility for lost or stolen items left on the premises or from accident or injury due to negligence of you, your group, or your vendors during the event. Furthermore, the Cartersville DDA reserves the right to prohibit anyone from selling at the market that is not in compliance with the rules and regulations set forth in this application.

***Note: The market requires vendors to be in compliance with all applicable State and Federal regulations regarding products sold, including the labeling of all non-regulated items. Licenses/certifications are required for the sale of regulated products such as live plants, eggs, meat products, dairy products, products sold as "organic", and low acid foods (canned vegetables, pickles, salsas, etc.). For questions regarding licenses/certifications to sell regulated products in Georgia, contact the Georgia Department of Agriculture at 404-656-3627. These products cannot be legally sold in the State of Georgia without the proper certifications.**

Products exempt from the Georgia Food Act, which are not governed by additional State or Federal laws and regulations include: fresh produce, jams, jellies, and honey.
